Hi everyone,

The recent warm weather belies the fact that it is already autumn. The first school term is almost over and Easter and Anzac Day are fast approaching.

The first three months of the year have been very busy for everyone at CCC. Following our annual staff planning day in January, we launched into a full program of events and activities. Our program of Cultural Bus Tours for seniors has commenced with our first destination being the Jewish Museum in Sydney and this will be followed by a trip to Joadja Creek in May. Our Sessions for seniors program is recommencing in April with a presentation from Centrelink and we have arranged a number of very interesting guest presenters as part of this program including speakers from Legal Aid; the Black Dog Institute; and Alzheimer's Australia. This program targets seniors but anyone in the community that is interested is most welcome to attend.

All of our regular programs for youth, children and families have recommenced for the year and in March we celebrated Seniors Week with a High Tea. As part of our focus in bringing different groups in our community together, we had the members of Mt Annan High Girls Group helping to serve the seniors at the High Tea. Seniors Week is closely followed by Youth Week 6th-12th April when we are hosting a beauty workshop for youth with a disability.


In February our first Quarterly Networking event was well attended and as part of our ongoing strategy to better connect and engage with the community our first quarterly community barbeque is on 1st April in the Narellan library forecourt. There will be free sausage sandwiches as well as music and entertainment provided by the circus group from Campbelltown Performing Arts High School.

The staff at CCC are currently working on a project funded by NSW Veteran Affairs and Camden Council to commemorate the centenary of the commencement of WWI. This is an exciting project that involves the making of a DVD - "Camden Anzacs - Our Story" Local high school students will interview Camden Anzacs and the DVD will be launched at Camden Civic Centre on the 4th August 2014, exactly 100 years since the commencement of WWI. We are excited and honoured to have this opportunity to record the history of our local Anzacs and are looking forward to viewing and then distributing the completed DVD. During April we will also be launching an Anzac Poetry competition for local school children and the winners of this competition will be announced in April 2015 to coincide with the 100 year commemoration of Anzac Day.

On 12th May 2014 we will be relocating to our new premises in the Narellan Child, Family and Community Centre located across the road from Narellan Town Centre and not far from our current location. We expect that there will only be minimal interruption to our services during the week of the move. You will find there is easy access to our new office and our phone number and postal address will remain unchanged.

COOKERY CORNER

ANZAC BISCUITS

Ingredients

- 1 cup plain flour
- 1 cup rolled oats
- 1 cup desiccated coconut
- 3/4 cup brown sugar
- 125g butter
- 2 tablespoons golden syrup
- 1 teaspoon bicarbonate of soda
- 2 tablespoons water

Method

- 1. Preheat oven to 160°C.
- 2. Line 2 baking trays with non-stick baking paper
- 3. Sift the flour into a large bowl. Stir in the oats, coconut and brown sugar.
- 4. Put the butter, golden syrup and water in a small saucepan.
- 5. Stir over a medium heat until melted. Stir in the bicarbonate of soda.
- 6. Pour the butter mixture into the flour mixture and stir until combined.
- 7. Roll the mixture into balls. Place on the trays, about 5cm apart.
- 8. Press with a fork to flatten slightly.
- 9. Bake for ten minutes or until golden brown.
- 10. Allow to cool for five minutes on the trays and then transfer to a wire rack to cool completely.
