I don't know if you feel the same, but it seems as though this year is just flying past. We are already heading towards the end of winter and spring will soon be in the air.

A key highlight for CCC staff has been our recent move to new premises. We are now located in the Narellan Child, Family and Community Centre, just across the road from Narellan Town Centre. After the initial challenge of moving, we have now settled in to our lovely new offices and if you haven't already visited, why not pop in and say hello?

The past few months has seen a busy schedule of program and activities. The sketching program held during May and June was very successful and we have now scheduled another Connecting Women Art program to be held at Narellan, commencing in October. We also held another cooking workshop during June and we will be continuing to hold cooking workshops during the coming year, with the next one scheduled for 17th September at the Macarthur Centre for Sustainable Living.

Our program of bus tours for seniors continues to be very popular. In June we took a group of seniors to Gledswood and on 18th July twenty seniors visited Train Works at Thirlmere and had lunch at the Common Ground Café at Picton. The second of our shopping trips took place in June with a trip to Wetherill Park and we continue to offer a quarterly bus service to Leppington Cemetery. We have a few more bus tours scheduled for this year with dates yet to be confirmed.

During the school holidays we ran two Kids Club activities. In the first week we ran a martial arts skills workshop and in the second week we ran a cooking workshop. We will again be running Kids Club during the next school holidays. workers.

For young people 12-18 years we have commenced a Winter Thursday Night Outreach program, and for further details about this program, you can speak to one of our youth Workers

We also held our second quarterly community BBQ during the school holidays. Our quarterly BBQs, held in front of the library, aim to promote our organisation to the community, and we were pleased to have almost 140 people in attendance. We will hold our next quarterly BBQ during the September school holidays, so come along and share in the community spirit while enjoying a free sausage sandwich. Also, don't forget our next quarterly networking event which is on Wednesday 27th August, starting at 4.30pm at the Macarthur Centre for Sustainable Living. This will be a special occasion as we will be showing our recently completed DVD, "Camden Anzacs- Our Story".

In other news, the Tax Help Program is now available. We are only able to offer this service on a Saturday and anyone interested in accessing this service should book quickly as appointments are filling quickly. CCC in conjunction with Macarthur Legal also offer access to free legal advice. The service is offered on the first Wednesday of every month, and bookings are essential.

CCC is a member based organisation, and once again it is time for membership renewals. These are being sent out to members but if you are not already a member and would like to join, it only costs \$5 per year. Being a member of CCC gives you the opportunity to actively participate in your local community organisation and will keep you updated about our programs and activities. 

COOKERY CORNER

Ingredients

6 Granny Smith apples
1/2 cup caster sugar
2 tablespoons water
2 eggs, at room temperature
1 teaspoon vanilla essence
1/2 cup self-raising flour
Ice-cream and whipped cream,
to serve



Method

Preheat oven to 180°C. Lightly grease a 5-cup capacity ovenproof dish.

Peel, core and chop apples. Place in a saucepan with 1/4 cup sugar and water. Cook, partially covered, over medium heat for 5 to 8 minutes or until apple is tender. Drain excess liquid. Spoon apple into prepared dish. Cover to keep warm.

Using an electric mixer, beat eggs until light and fluffy. Add remaining 1/4 cup sugar, 1 tablespoon at a time, beating until thick and creamy. Stir in vanilla.

Sift flour over batter. Using a metal spoon, fold through batter. Pour over hot stewed apple.

Bake for 30 minutes or until a skewer inserted into the sponge comes out clean.
